- Minimum age: 18 (younger ages considered on application).



# Red Seedless Watermelon, Chicken and Rocket Salad

## INGREDIENTS - Serves 8

- 1 Mini Me® red seedless watermelon
- 30g (1/3 cup) flaked almonds
- 500g cooked chicken, shredded
- 6 tbsp olive oil
- 3 tbsp white wine vinegar
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 2 ½ tbsp grainy mustard
- 200g baby rocket leaves
- Handful coriander leaves



## METHOD

1. Heat a frying pan over medium heat. Add almonds and dry-fry, shaking pan regularly for about 2 minutes until golden. Remove from pan.
2. Cut watermelon into small chunks and place in a bowl with chicken. Combine oil, vinegar and mustard and add a little pepper. Whisk to combine.
3. Arrange rocket leaves in a bowl. Add watermelon and chicken. Drizzle over dressing and toss gently to combine. Scatter over coriander leaves and toasted almonds to serve.
